Question: What is the cost per person?

Question: Are there any discounts?

- Yes, for students (valid id), children aged 12 or below, seniors aged 60 or above (valid id), persons with disabilities (valid certificate). There are also family ticket and group bookings.

Question: Can tickets be bought on site or in advance only?

- Both are available:
 - o Onsite at the reception desk but be prepared to queue before entering the VR experience
 - Online using <u>China Travel Service</u> website, our online provider for a ticket (specific timeslot).

Question: What is the process for getting a refund?

- Tickets are non-refundable except in the following circumstances:
 - o T8 Signal When Typhoon signal number 8 or above is hoisted, the Museum will be closed and remain closed if the signal is lowered less than two hours before the normal closing time. Tickets that have been sold via online platform can be refunded through the China Travel Service ticketing platform.
 - Black Rainstorm If Black Rainstorm warning is lifted less than two hours before the normal closing time, the Museum will not re-open for the day. Tickets that have been sold via online platform can be refunded through the China Travel Service ticketing platform

VR QUESTIONS:

Question: How long the VR experience lasts?

- Arrive 10 minutes early to queue and get the headset ready. Note that at busy periods you may
 have to wait longer than your allotted VR scheduled time.
- Experience lasts about 30 minutes.

Question: What languages is the VR in?

- The VR has three language options just ask the staff when you get your headset.
 - o Cantonese
 - o Putonghua
 - o English

Question: How many people per session?

• 35 people maximum per session

Question: When is the last session per day?

- Museum opening: Monday to Friday: 09:30 17:30, last session is 15:30-17:00
- Museum opening: Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays: 10:00-19:00, <u>last session is 16:00-18:00</u>
- Note 6 October the last session is from 13:30-15:00 (Mid-autumn Festival).

Question: What restrictions are there?

- <u>Children</u> This experience is only open to children aged 4 or above. Children aged 4 to 12 must be accompanied by a guardian.
- <u>Pregnant women</u> Pregnant women who are more than 6 months along are advised to purchase tickets with caution.
- <u>Medical conditions</u> Individuals with epilepsy, severe acrophobia, or heart diseases are not permitted to enter.
- General health Those with other medical conditions should consult a doctor before the experience.

Question: Do I need to pay for the exhibition?

- Yes. The general museum ticket (Adult: HKD 30) includes already the admission to the special exhibition. However, the "Exploring Sanxingdui VR Experience" located in the Special Events Gallery requires a special exhibition ticket.
- You do not need to do the VR experience to visit the exhibition
